



Residential Treatment for Children and Teens
with Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q | HOW LONG WILL MY CHILD BE AT THE PROGRAM?

A | The average length of stay is 3-6 months.

Q | HOW LONG ARE HOME VISITS AND HOW OFTEN?

A | Home passes will begin when deemed appropriate by the treatment team. Typically, home passes are scheduled for 1-3 days and at least one home pass is expected prior to discharge.

Q | HOW OFTEN WILL WE HAVE FAMILY SESSIONS?

A | Family therapy sessions will occur weekly with the therapist, or as other issues arise. You can call or email the therapist as needed as well.

Q | HOW OFTEN WILL MY CHILD BE ABLE TO CALL ME?

A | Each resident is allowed phone calls two days per week (Tuesday-Saturday) and one call per day, limited to 10-15 minutes. Phone calls are scheduled upon admission with his/ her assigned case manager.

Q | WHEN CAN I CONSULT WITH THE PSYCHIATRIST?

A | You can consult with a psychiatrist during weekly treatment team and by appointment as needed.

Q | DOES NORRIS ACADEMY ACCOMMODATE SPECIAL DIETARY NEEDS?

A | Yes, accommodations are made for special dietary needs based on physician's orders.

Q | HOW OFTEN IS FOOD PROVIDED?

A | All residents are offered three meals and two snacks every day.

Q | WHO WILL PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION?

A | Legal guardians will be responsible for transportation for admission and other appointments. If the child is in state's custody, staff at Norris will collaborate with the state regarding necessary transportation.

Q | WHEN CAN I COME VISIT MY CHILD?

A | We encourage frequent visits after your child has been at Norris for 72 hours. During treatment, families are required to complete two on-site visits. After the completion of those visits, residents may begin off-site visits with guardians that are coordinated with the child's therapist.

Q | WHAT ACADEMICS ARE OFFERED AND WHAT DOES A SCHOOL DAY LOOK LIKE?

A | Norris Academy follows the Anderson County School Schedule. During the regular school year the students attend school Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. and during the summer the school schedule is 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.

Q | WHAT SHOULD I PACK FOR MY CHILD TO BRING TO NORRIS?

A | Norris provides clothing for residents. Guardians are responsible to bring socks, underwear, and shoes. *(Details of packing are in our handbook; please limit the number of personal items that are packed.)* We recommend to not pack anything for your child that will not come back in good repair.
